Helping your child transition to ABC

ABC Children's Center understands that starting at a new school can be difficult for a child. We recommend the following plan to make the transition an easy one, however, we will work with you in any way that will make your child's first days at ABC a pleasant one.

1. Transitioning also gives us a chance to get to know your child so that the right placement is made.
2. Talk to your child about his/her new school and what to expect.
3. We highly recommend you come in for a connection time/play date the week before your child's start date for about an hour or less. This allows your child time to get comfortable with the teacher, children, and environment before you leave your child on his/her own. During a visit you may want to tell your child that you are going to the other room for a short time and then return in about 10 minutes.
4. Make a big deal about your child's first day at preschool. Leave your child for an hour or two the first day. Call in at any time to check on your child. If your child is getting overly stressed, we may suggest that your child has had enough for the first day. During this transition time we will charge you hourly.
5. Extend the hours on future days until your child is settled in to his/her regular schedule.

Thank you for choosing ABC as a place for your child to learn and grow. We want the transition to our school to be as smooth as possible.
